## SEWP VI Ordering Guide

Program overview, fair opportunity information, and ordering support for Federal customers

### SEWP Overview

NASA SEWP (Solutions for Enterprise-Wide Procurement), pronounced “soup,” provides the latest Information Technology, Communications, and Audio-Visual (ITC/AV) solutions and services for all Federal agencies and their approved contractors. Created in 1993, SEWP I was the first Government-Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) in the federal acquisition space. Originally, the contract vehicle provided only technology products for NASA and other agencies. SEWP has continually evolved over the past 30 years, expanding its scope to meet the needs of its customers, and represents acquisition innovation within the Federal Government. The program is self-funded through a usage fee (0.34%) and supports all Federal agencies with acquisition support — more than 50,000 orders a year.

### Fair Opportunity & Requests for Quotes

Cloud9 Security Services' SEWP VI award is one of multiple awards issued under the NASA SEWP VI Government-Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC). Contractors are given a fair opportunity to be considered for each order at the individual order level, as appropriate, per FAR Part 16.505(b), including use of the SEWP online Request for Quote (RFQ) tools. No documentation of order selection is required to be submitted with the order — such documentation is maintained by the issuing procurement office.

**FAR 16.505(b)(1):** Each contractor shall be given a fair opportunity to be considered for each order exceeding the micro-purchase threshold issued under multiple-award contracts. The method for obtaining fair opportunity is at the discretion of the ordering Contracting Officer, who must document the rationale for the placement and price of each order. Cloud9 Security Services will respond to RFQs issued through the NASA SEWP online quoting system with items available on our SEWP VI contract, priced no greater than the SEWP database of record at the time the quote is issued, consistent with the SEWP VI Contract Holder User Manual (CHUM).

## What's in Scope for SEWP VI?

SEWP is designed to provide a broad suite of Information Technology, Communications, and Audio-Visual (ITC/AV) solutions and services. SEWP's processes enable Contract Holders to add new commercial technology and IT services to their contract daily, as requested by customers. SEWP VI is composed of three scope categories:

### CATEGORY A

#### ITC/AV Solutions

Information technology, communications, and audio-visual hardware and software solutions.

### CATEGORY B

#### Enterprise-Wide Service Solutions

Enterprise-wide ITC/AV service solutions supporting agency-level requirements.

### CATEGORY C — CLOUD9

#### Mission-Based Services

Mission-based ITC/AV service solutions, including cybersecurity, cloud, and enterprise architecture services.

## Ordering Process

The internal ordering process of each Federal agency varies. The process and accompanying forms for Purchase Requests (PR) and Delivery Orders (DO) issued against this SEWP contract are defined by the issuing agency, not the NASA SEWP Program Management Office (PMO). Typically, an end-user determines a requirement and generates a Purchase Request (PR); the PR, along with any necessary funding information, is sent to that agency's procurement office, which results in the issuance of a Delivery Order (DO).

Cloud9 will respond with a formal quote consistent with our SEWP VI database of record pricing and the timeline requested in your RFQ. Once your agency's Delivery Order is issued and routed through the SEWP PMO, Cloud9 will begin performance and provide the program support outlined on page 1 for any installation, warranty, technical support, or order-troubleshooting needs.
